

On July 10th, 1943, The Hastings and Prince Edward Regiment, part of a force of 25,000 Canadian soldiers, landed west of Pachino on the southern most tip of Sicily. Operation Husky marked the beginning of the long Italian Campaign, which saw many hard fought battles. By the end of the Second World War, The Hastings and Prince Edward Regiment, which had left Picton, Ontario in December 1939 for overseas, had been awarded more battle honours than any other Canadian Regiment.
